

Inspiring Beautiful Noise

We couldn't make this impact without our Traveling School teachers. Highlighted here are teachers who have taught 4+ semesters, including Sarah White, who is an educator and activist in the Bay Area.

Across four Traveling School semesters, Sarah inspired students to reorient their perspectives on world issues, and to attain the capacity to think critically. Critical thinking is Sarah's obsession and key to making beautiful noise.

With roots in Paolo Friere's "Pedagogy of the Oppressed," Sarah aimed to empower students to become critical agents of change, questioning oppressive structures and working towards a more democratic and just society. Freire's framework is at the heart of how Sarah (and other Traveling School faculty) found distinctive ways to engage others, to inspire change, to make noise.


